ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE

The Clearfield Section of American Society of Highway Engineers is pleased to sponsor a scholarship program for the 2024 school year.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. AMOUNT:

At least one scholarship in the amount of \$2,500.00 will be awarded in May 2024.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- (A) The applicant must be a citizen of the United States, or have permanent resident status, and be enrolled in a Pennsylvania based College of Civil/Transportation Engineering.
- (B) The applicant must have a **Junior or Senior** status in a four year **Civil/Transportation Engineering** Degree program upon returning to school in January 2024 or have obtained an associate degree and is continuing education in a highway related field of engineering.
- (C) The curriculum in which the applicant is enrolled should have a major emphasis in one of the fields of surveying, geotechnical engineering, environmental engineering, construction inspection and management, highway and bridge design, transportation materials engineering and inspection, or traffic and ITS engineering following fields: surveying, geotechnical (soils), environmental, structural, construction and inspection, highway design and materials of construction.
- (D) Each applicant must complete the scholarship application form and provide all requested information.
- (E) The applicant is eligible to <u>receive</u> the award only one time.
- (F) Applicants not selected are encouraged to reapply provided they still meet the application criteria.

3. EVALUATION:

Each applicant will be evaluated on a "point-count" system as described below:

(A) Scholarship Performance (25 points maximum)

Applicant will be rated on their G.P.A. A current transcript must be submitted with the application.

(B) **ASHE Association** (bonus 5 points)

Applicants who are a dependent of an ASHE member of 3 years or more in good standing, or who are ASHE members of 3 or more years, will receive 5 bonus points.

(C) PA Resident (bonus 5 points)

Applicants who are PA residents enrolled in a Pennsylvania Civil/Transportation Engineering School will receive 5 bonus points.

(D) **Personal Evaluation** (75 points maximum)

Applicants will be rated on awards, community and school activities and work experience (45 available points).

Applicants will be rated on their written description of their career goals, based on content, clarity or ambitions, grammar, spelling and appearance (30 available points).

(E) Personal Interview

A minimum of three applicants with the highest scores in (A) Scholastic Performance and (D) Personal Evaluation will be invited for an interview. This interview will be a subjective evaluation of the applicant's attitude toward civil engineering, ability to communicate, career goals and appearance.
